Frequently Asked Questions

Why do I need to register? What will it cost?

Registration will help the coordinators with logistics, preparations, and facilities. It will allow us to get your study guides needed for the training. There is no fee for the classes. The only costs you will pay are for the purchase of your study guides (about \$10) and for buying your lunch (about \$10) on a field trip.

Where is the Phoenix room located?

It is located in the Student Union building of the UT Dallas campus. Directions will be sent upon registration. In the event of a change in venue, we will inform you. Evening classes hosted by ICF will begin at 7:30 p.m. with prayer led by an international student from UT Dallas.

Are the participants required to serve with ICF ministries on campus?
